



When I planned to put up a tower and I only had room for one, I wanted to top it with an antenna with multiple band coverage like 5-6 bands as opposed to a tri-band. My friend has a 2-el SteppIR and talked often about how nice it is to push a button on the controller and instantly change bands and even the direction by 180° whenever he wanted. Based on the wind load limits for my tower, I decided on the 3-el Yagi SteppIR 20m-6m.

My SteppIR Yagi has worked great since I purchased it from SteppIR in 2019. My former antenna was a 6-band Hex Beam which worked well, but I appreciate the better directional ability of the SteppIR and its increased gain. My DX count quickly went up during the first year I had the antenna up. After three plus years of use, the antenna is still in great shape.

I really like the ability to change bands with a single button push and I rarely use my antenna rotator since I can change the antenna to Bi-directional mode or 180° mode via my SDA 2000 controller in just a couple of seconds. Being in California that works great for working DX in Asia Pacific and SA at the same time.

There were times that I had to repair an issue with the antenna and they were entirely my fault. With SteppIR tech support department and using the troubleshooting guide online, I was easily able to resolve all the issues!
